TO EXPLAIN (in age appropriate terms) TO YOUTH: Youth should be aware that this information is gathered to evaluate the program and that the information they share will be made known to program administrators and funding authorities. Youth should also be informed that the information they provide will be used in charts & graphics for the web – BUT THAT ALL IDENTIFYING INFORMATION IS KEPT CONFIDENTIAL. Participation in the Exit Interview is encouraged, but voluntary. The more honest and forthright the student is about the program, the more helpful their information will be; let students know that information they give to you will not hurt your feelings and that unless something they say does not make sense, you will not ask questions about anything they say to you. In most cases, you will quote, word for word, the statement made by the student; if what they say is unclear, you will simply re-read the question; if the youth does not understand the question - they may ask you to clarify. The primary goal for the provider in this exit interview is to see if the questions asked, have been answered (it is not to discuss whether or not you agree with the answer). If a youth cannot give a clear or logical answer to a question due to skill set, etc. etc. – after you ask the question again, simply quote them, and go onto the next question.
